Bangladesh and Germany maintain strong and steadily developing economic ties, supported by active trade relations and long-standing business engagement. In November, Bangladesh is set to graduate from the group of Least Developed Countries, a significant milestone in its economic development. This also means that after a three-year transition period, Bangladesh will lose quota and duty-free access to the European market under the Everything but Arms scheme. It is in our collective interest for this transition to take place smoothly so that trade and investment flows are not negatively impacted. We welcome efforts by Bangladesh's Government to gain access to the GSP+ regime, which offers preferential access to the European market, and are supporting these efforts through our development cooperation. However, additional efforts will be necessary to meet the relevant requirements, especially in the fields of human and labour rights. Businesses can play an important role in advocating for these improvements, which are crucial to sustaining Bangladesh's export-driven development model.

In this context, the Bangladesh-German Chamber of Commerce and Industry (BGCCI) plays a valuable role. By supporting dialogue with different stakeholders, facilitating business and committing to German business interests, BGCCI contributes to a fair and constructive business ecosystem in Bangladesh.



The outlook for bilateral economic cooperation remains positive. The return to a democratically ruled Bangladesh with the elections in February 2026 represents a new start, which will be closely monitored by investors and business people alike. There is considerable scope to expand collaboration across both established and emerging sectors, provided that political and economic reforms are fully implemented.

The German Embassy remains committed to supporting German businesses in Bangladesh and to further strengthening our economic collaboration in the year ahead. I wish BGCCI and its members ongoing success and look forward to continuing to promote our bilateral relations.

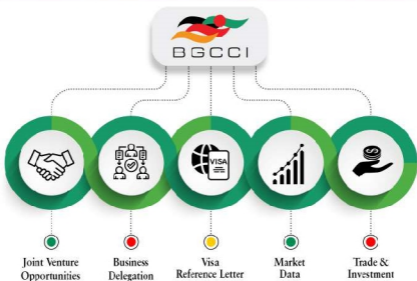
